Whereas the property located at Block 43, Lot 1 has applied for removal from the BID and the Tax Assessor has advised that the property was at one time classified as Class 4A, but the property has since been sold, and the new owner uses the property strictly for residential purposes, thus confirming the owner's believe that the property should be removed from the BID, and

**Whereas** should the use of the property change in the future, the Tax Assessor will notify the Mayor and Council accordingly,

**Now, Therefore, be it resolved** that the property located at Block 43, Lot 1 is hereby removed from the financial obligations of being located within the Business Improvement District, and shall not be subject to the special or added assessment levied upon properties located in the Business Improvement District.
