**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE OVER THE LIMIT  
UNDER ARREST 2011 STATWIDE CRACKDOWN**

**WHEREAS**, impaired drivers on our nation's roads kill someone every 30 minutes, 50 people per day and almost 18,000 people each year; and

**WHEREAS**, 25% of motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey are alcohol-related; and

**WHEREAS**, the summer season and the Labor Day holiday in particular are traditionally times of social gatherings which include alcohol; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, has asked law enforcement agencies throughout the state to participate in the Over the Limit Under Arrest 2011 Statewide Crackdown; and

**WHEREAS**, the project will involve increased impaired driving enforcement from August 19<sup>th</sup> through September 5, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, an increase in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving will save lives on our roadways.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Governing Body of the Borough of Highlands declares its support for the Over the Limit Under Arrest 2011 Statewide Crackdown from August 19 through September 5, 2011 and pledges to increase awareness of the dangers of drinking and driving.
