RESOLUTION APPOINTING A CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

Whereas, the Code of the Borough of Highlands, Section 2-12.2 establishes the position of Code Enforcement Officer within the Department of Buildings and Housing; and

Whereas, the Code provides for appointment by the Mayor, with advice and consent of the Council for a term of one (1) year; and

Whereas, the Borough wishes to appoint a Code Enforcement Officer for the term of January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014; and

Whereas, the Code Enforcement Officer shall be required to work 20 hours per week at an annual salary of \$20,808

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Highlands, that the Borough hereby appoints Dave Mercado to serve as Code Enforcement Officer from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014.

Be It further resolved that Elaine Broyles be appointment as an additional Code Enforcement Officer.
