The provisions of Section 5-7.6 Leashing of Dogs and Section 5-12 Soiling and Defecating—Domesticated Animals shall at all times apply to the use of Block 114 Lot 3.02 (Shore Drive) and Block 8 Lot 2 (South Bay Ave) by any person or domestic animal.
