BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Highlands, a municipal Corporation of the State of New Jersey;

SECTION 2-11.4 “MEMBERS” OF SECTION 2-11 “FIRE DEPARTMENT” IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

2-11.4 Members

Candidates for membership must not be less than 18 or more than 46 years of age (unless they have served as a volunteer firefighter previous to his/her 46th birthday), and must be of good moral character, pass a satisfactory physical examination by a designated physician, and must have been a resident of the Borough of Highlands not less than one year prior to submission of application **either: a resident of the Borough of Highlands not less than one year prior to submission of the application, or work in the Borough of Highlands, or have otherwise shown an ability or circumstances allowing the prospective member to respond to emergencies within the Borough of Highlands.**
