## BOROUGH OF HIGHLANDS BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARIES

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Borough of Highlands, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey on March 16, 2011 and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Grants (if any) Appropriated: \$250,000 expected to be received as a grant from the New Jersey

and \$183,603 expected to be received as a Community Development Block Grant.
