

Attention Outdoor Cat Caregivers

Do you want to help save the lives of free-roaming cats in Highlands? Do you feed and care for homeless cats who live outside (sometimes called feral cats)? Exciting news- Highlands has passed a Trap-Neuter-Release (TNR) ordinance for free-roaming, homeless cats in partnership with the Monmouth County SPCA. One of the requirements of the new ordinance requires that anyone feeding free-roaming cats must be registered with the MCSPCA to continue to feed so we can start helping these cats in an efficient way.
