A determination letter for FEMA assistance that doesn't begin with "You're approved" may simply mean that more information or documentation is required. Call the FEMA Helpline at 800-621-FEMA if you have questions. And you can always appeal if you believe FEMA got it wrong. See the news release for details.

N.J. unemployment insurance office phone systems are busy! For improved service, file your disaster unemployment insurance claim **online** at **NJuifile.net**. Benefits are paid faster to those who certify on Sundays from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. via the internet.

DRCs/BRCs NOW CLOSED SUNDAYS
