Good news! As a result of increased demand for furnaces due to storm replacements, the minimum furnace efficiency requirement for the rebates was broadened to 92% AFUE for units purchased on or after October 29, 2012.		
Boilers		
Incentives	\$1,400 (\$500 NJCEP and \$900 NJNG)	
Hydronic units must have an AFUE ≥ 85% and be ENERGY STAR®. Steam units must have an AFUE of ≥ 82%.

Good news! Eligible equipment was expanded to include .67 EF ENERGY STAR power-vented water heaters.		
Air Conditioning		
Incentives	Central A/C System \$500 or Ductless Mini Split \$700 Minimum Efficiency ≥ SEER* 16 and EER 13	

Plus Superstorm Sandy Recovery customers can also access ...

- \$50 incentive for the installation of qualified clothes washers
 - Clothes washers must have a modified energy factor (MEF) of 2.2 or higher
- Enhanced incentives for NJCEP Commercial Programs
- Residential New Construction
 - Smart Growth Area requirement waived for projects in designated areas
 - Projects must be qualified and enrolled on or after 10/29/12 and prior to 6/30/13

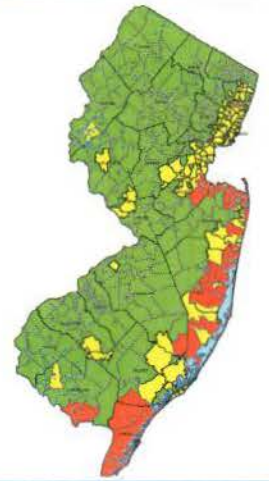

BUSINESSES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

Increased Financial Incentives

Incentives available through NJ SmartStart Buildings have been increased by 50% for those affected by Hurricane Sandy. Significantly reduce your costs when you upgrade to energy efficiency. Equipment purchased on or after October 29, 2012 is eligible while funding lasts. Smart Growth requirements are being waived for new construction projects in eligible areas impacted by Hurricane Sandy.



Streamlined and Modified Requirements

- Pre-inspections and pre-approvals will be waived where appropriate, as will equipment inventory requirements for those with proof of pre-existing conditions (i.e. maintenance records, recent photographs and energy audit reports).
- Restrictions on performance lighting measures in major rehabilitation projects have been eliminated.
- Planned discontinuation of incentives for premium motors and T12 lighting has been extended from March 1, 2013 to June 30, 2013.

Additional Incentives

To help get food providers back in business, we've also added incentives for qualifying high-efficiency food service equipment including:

- Dishwashers
- Fryers
- Griddles
- Hot Food Holding Cabinets
- Ice Machines
- Ovens
- Refrigerators & Freezers
- Steam Cookers

* If you are located outside of the eligible zip code list, you may qualify for increased incentives by demonstrating that you have experienced damage caused by Hurricane Sandy. Applications for Hurricane Sandy relief incentives will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

New Jersey's Clean Energy Program is offering customers who are replacing equipment/appliances in a home or business damaged by Hurricane Sandy enhanced incentives when purchasing high efficiency equipment. These enhanced incentives are in addition to current incentives in place for purchasing high efficiency equipment.

All customers requesting increased incentives due to damage caused by Hurricane Sandy are required to submit a signed certification form.

Customer's place of residence should be located in a Sandy designated area (see eligible zip code list) or if your residence is outside of the zip code list, you may qualify for increased incentives by demonstrating that you experienced damage caused by Hurricane Sandy. Applications for Hurricane Sandy relief incentives will be reviewed on a case by case basis. Please contact 866-NJ-SMART for additional information.

Please read and acknowledge the statement below that certifies that you are a customer that has been impacted by Hurricane Sandy.

I certify that I have experienced damage caused by Hurricane Sandy and I am requesting New Jersey's Clean Energy Program's enhanced incentives. I also certify that these incentives, in conjunction with any FEMA or Homeowner's insurance payments that I have received, will not exceed the total cost of the equipment to be replaced.
