This will be a three-month community engagement process that commenced with the Steering Committee meeting and will conclude in early October. *Highlands Recovery* includes a series of community sessions for our residents, business owners, and



property owners to move Highlands beyond recovery and into the future. The Borough is collaborating on this effort with FEMA, NJ Future, and the Bloustein School of Planning and Public Policy of Rutgers University.
