

NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY O-14-5

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Borough of Highlands, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, on February 19, 2014. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Highlands Elementary School located at 360 Navesink Ave, Highlands, NJ 07732 on March 5, 2014 at 8:00 o'clock p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of the full bond ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The Clerk's Office is located at 42 Shore Drive, Highlands, NJ 07732. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$50,000 FOR REPLACEMENT OF FORCE MAINS IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF HIGHLANDS, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$50,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH TO FINANCE THE COST THEREOF.

Purpose(s): replacement of force mains to connect with the Township of Middletown Sewerage Authority's interceptor main, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

Appropriation: \$50,000

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$50,000

Section 20 Costs: \$50,000

Useful Life: 30 years
